Purpose of program: To reduce and eliminate drug use

Policy components:

Covered persons: Athletes, students in extracurricular activities and students driving to school

Type of testing: Random on a weekly basis, Monday through Saturday; end of suspension period if wish to re-enter activities/driving to school; follow-up periodic: monthly for 3 months following re-entry to activities

Method of testing: School Nurse, Principal, Athletic Director may supervise test collection, chain of custody procedures for specimen, privacy protections, certified lab for testing

Test payment: District pays for random tests  
Student/Parents pay for any specimen re-test upon appeal of results  
Student/Parents pay for test required to resume participation and follow-up testing

Substances tested: Not listed in the policy

Consequences: Positive test  
1<sup>st</sup> offense - 21-day suspension from activities or driving to school if student and at least one (1) parent/guardian attends three (3) drug awareness classes; 42-day suspension from activities or driving to school if do not attend drug awareness classes.  
2<sup>nd</sup> offense - suspension from activities or driving to school for one (1) calendar year.  
Multiple offenses - referral for professional evaluation paid by parent/guardian in addition to continued activity/driving suspension.
